Loving God and others, we invite, welcome and embrace all people through worship, fellowship, and service.

Come, Holy Spirit: The Day of Pentecost is May 28



As we approach the Day of Pentecost, we are reminded that God has poured the Holy Spirit out on all flesh (Acts 2:17), equipping us to bear witness to Jesus with love and power. As the Great Fifty Days of Easter draw to a close, I invite us to ponder the ninth-century hymn called "Come Creator Spirit." (Veni Creator Spiritus. For this translation, see Hymns 501 and 502 in the Hymnal.)

The first stanza reminds us that the Spirit plays a creative role in the resurrection of the dead. In the words of the Nicene Creed, the Spirit is the Lord and giver of life:

O Holy Spirit, by whose breath, life rises vibrant out of death. Come to create, renew, inspire; come, kindle in our hearts your fire.

Here, the Spirit is conceived as the One who raises the dead and inspires us to love other people like Jesus does. Later, in the fourth and fifth stanzas, the Spirit is described as the giver of wisdom and revelation, as well as the bond of peace. In our selfish and violent age, even the followers of Jesus need to be reminded of the peace he brings us. For Jesus rises from the dead to forgive us and empower us to love—to unite us as one Body, with a single mission, changing lives:

Flood our dull senses with your light; In mutual love our hearts unite; Your power the whole creation fills; Confirm our weak, uncertain wills.

From inner strife grant us release; Turn nations to the ways of peace; To fuller life your people bring, That as one body we may sing.

Throughout the month of May, I invite you to do what Jesus told his first followers to do: to wait for the promises of God (Acts 1:4). For the love, peace, and unity that we are promised through the Spirit are signs to a watching world of the life-changing power of Jesus. All the fruits of the Spirit serve our Christian witness to our neighbors, namely "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." (Galatians 5:22-23) "O Holy Spirit, by whose breath, life rises vibrant out of death." Come, Holy Spirit! Come!
