# A Meditation for Thanksgiving Day

"You crown the year with your goodness, and your paths overflow with plenty. May the fields of the wilderness be rich for grazing, and the hills be clothed with joy." (Psalm 65:12- 13) This Psalm is a harvest song, and so it is appointed for Thanksgiving Day. It points us to the staggering abundance of creation--and to God as the "giver of every good and perfect gift." (James 1:17)



For many of us, Thanksgiving Day is the last serious observance of the Sabbath. Like the weekly rest commanded in the Torah, Thanksgiving Day is a time to pause and worship-to give thanks to God. Creation is itself a grace. So, too are Jesus and the Spirit, who restore our broken fellowship with God and each other. Thanksgiving is a time to thank God for our many blessings.

Christians have been celebrating a thanksgiving meal for nearly two thousand years. *Eucharistia* means "thanksgiving." The Eucharistic Prayer retells the story of the Last Supper and culminates in the Lord's Prayer and the breaking of the bread. Typically, we give thanks for creation, for God's covenant with Israel, and above all for Jesus Christ our Savior. This ritual meal points us to the sacred dimension of all meals. Any time we break bread with others (whether with our family and friends, or our church-community, or with total strangers), we give thanks to God, because life itself (and all that sustains it) comes to us as God's gift.

A few years ago at the Thanksgiving service for the Trinity School of Texas (the one where we gather food for those in need in our community), I shared a quotation from John Calvin. I first learned it from Marilynne Robinson in an essay she called *Open Thy Hand Wide.* "As God bestows his benefits upon us, let us beware that we acknowledge it towards him, by doing good to our neighbors whom he offers to us, so as we neither exempt ourselves from their [poverty], nor seclude them from our abundance, but gently make them partakers with us, as [people] that are linked together in an inseparable bond." If all is God's gift, nothing is our possession. It comes to us from God's own hands. Let us give thanks to God, and share our blessings with those in need.
