# Advent and Christmas: Be Thyself our King of Peace

There is no one who calls on your name, or attempts to take hold of you; for you have hidden your face from us, and have delivered us into the hand of our iniquity. Yet, O LORD, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are all the work of your hand. (Isaiah 64:7-8)

We hear these words on the First Sunday of Advent this year. As Vida Scudder (a devout laywoman recently added to our calendar of saints) notes, Advent reminds us to be "solemnly expectant of tremendous change." Advent is a season when we wait not just for the birth of Jesus, but for his return to judge the living and the dead. Isaiah is reminding us of the various ways that we have turned away from God—and away from each other. Just look at our self-centered, idolatrous, and violent behavior.

But it is equally important to hear the announcement of Good News: "Yet, O LORD, you are our Father. We are the clay, and you are the potter. We are all the work of your hand." For, in spite of our own inhumanity and injustice, we serve the living God, who is boundless in love for every last creature. On Christmas Eve at both 6 and 11 pm (and on Christmas Day at 10 am), we behold God's love for lost and wandering humanity. For, in the flesh of this poor and homeless Child, we have been adopted as God's children. And, by his grace, we are given strength to turn back to each other—and back to God.

This year, like many Christmases past and yet-to-come, we welcome the Prince of Peace in a world at war. As we hasten to Bethlehem to hail his birth, may we join our voices with the faithful in every generation:

O come, Desire of nations, bind in one the hearts of all mankind. Bid thou our sad divisions cease, And be thyself our King of Peace.

Sometimes our lives can feel like we are living in a never-ending night, without light, without hope, without resolution. It is times like these that we need God the most. During dark times I find it helpful to look back on the entirety of my life, not just now, and notice all the times God has been present and loving even when I couldn't see it. I remember feeling very discouraged and a woman at church asked me if I was okay. I explained my situation and she responded with joy. "God is doing something amazing with you," she said and prayed for me. That odd moment was transformational for me. I now use these words when I don't understand what God is up to and it calms me.

If you find yourself struggling, or know someone else who is, please consider joining us for The Longest Night Service on December 21st at 7:00 PM. We will have a Eucharistic service that honors those who are finding it hard to be joyful this Christmas season.


